


🌸 St. Paddy's Day Pin




1ST → cut green wool felt using
Cuttlebug "funky Circles Frame"
die.




2. Use the left over scrap 
to trace circle size
on to a piece of green foam.
This will serve as the back
of your pin. Follow trace lines
and cut circle out.

3.) Glue all of the rings from
the funky circle onto the
solid foam backing



4.) Cut flower shapes from the four up cuttlebug "Flowers" die




out of green craft foam.

5.) Glue 1 of the outer flowers down on top of the felt circle rings.




6.) Cut a circle tag shape out of the cuttlebug "tags" that come w/ the fruit dies.




use a different color foam - Green - but a diff. green than the flower shapes.

glue this circle tag on top of the flower shape.



- 7.) Cut a flower shape out of green wool felt using the cuttlebug "Honey comb" flowers. Glue this on top of the tag.




note: leave the stem on to hang off.



honey comb flws.
Die - for cuttlebug

- 8.) Pull the inside tear drop shapes from the previously cut out foam flowers.




Snip the points off from four of them. Glue them down on top of the "honey comb" flower in a 4 leaf clover shape.



Also glue down the left-over diamond shapes from the cut foam flowers.

9.) Grab the left over foam dot that popped out of the "circle tag" and glue that to the very top.



10.) For the final step - Flip the Pin over (once all the glue is dry!) And glue on a pin blank.
