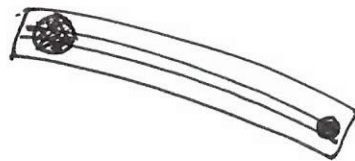
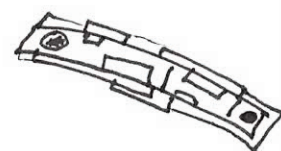
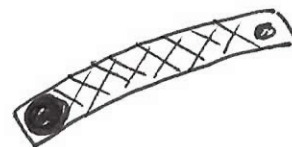


CUFF BRACELET

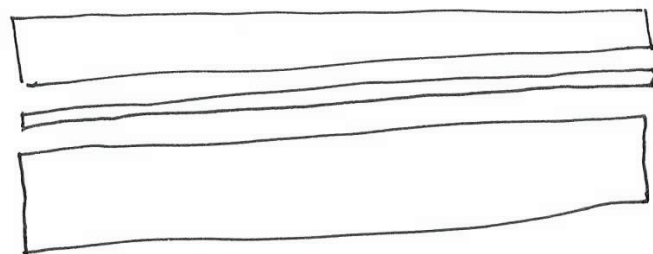


I spent an afternoon cutting ImaginiscE "LIVE LOUD" papers into strips and layering them to create this series of super deluxe cute cuff bracelets!

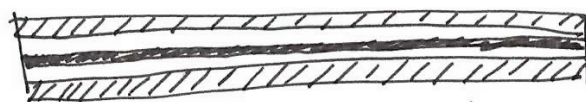


Step 1.) Gather a stack of paper to work with. Cut strips long enough to fit the end wearers wrist and as wide as you'd like cuff to be.

Because you'll want to layer-cut all different widths - but same lengths.



2.) Stack layers on top of each other.

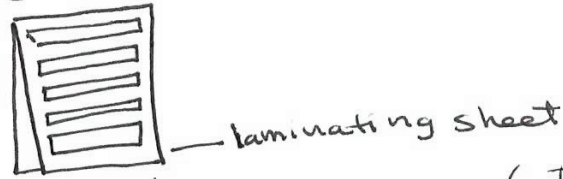


Attach w/ a glue stick.

3.) Make several of these, all different, to create the base for several bracelets.



4.) line all of the layered paper bracelet bases up in an 8 1/2 x 11 laminating sheet.



Run all at once (I was able to fit 7) through the lower laminator of the Your Story Machine.



5.) Once they are double sided laminated - cut them in strips again. I used both a straight edge and I used pinking shears to create some w/ pinkered edges.



6.) Now using the Imaginisce itop i created magnet clasps and decorative brads and a couple of flowers w/ the itop punches.

7.) Follow the itop instructions to make different size magnets and brads - Using the same papers as the rest on your bracelet bases. I used Imaginisce "Live Loud" papers.

8.) Also, I used the itop flower looking punches to create layers.



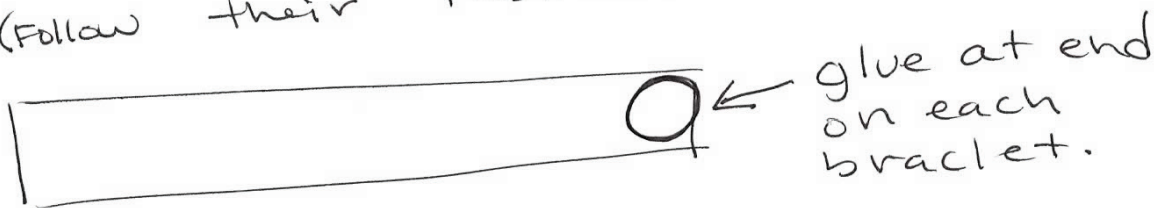
that I DIDN'T wrap around the blanks.



9.) Glue random flowers, Brads, buttons that you've made onto the bracelets.



10.) Now glue one magnet button you create to the end of each bracelet. I use E-600 Glue to ensure the magnet will stay on forever. (Follow their instructions)



11.) Now glue just a plain magnet to the opposite end of each bracelet. This will act as your clasp.
