1.) BUY OR HAVE CUT A THIN PIECE OF WOOD INTO A CIRCLE. SIZE TEMPLATE IS ATTACH ED AT END.



2.) PAINT WOOD (6)
W/ BROWN PAINT
USING A VERY
BRUSH STROKEY
METHOD.



3.) USE YOUR ROTERY CUTTER TO CUT 1/2 in. 3 /4in.wide BY Bin Long Brown paper (CARD STOCK is Best)

- 4.) COVER YOUR PAINTED WOOD (1)
 W/ MOD PODGE AND START
 TO RANDOMLY LAY DOWN
 THE BROWN PAPER STRIPS
 creating a scrappy nest.
- 5.) Once all the paper pieces are down "paint" more Mod podge over the entire surface.
- 6.) Now is the time to bust out your cricut. Choose a cartridge you like that has a bird on it. I used the Heritage cartridge to cut 3 Birds out of blue card Stock (8016) then I used the Tie the Knot Cartridge to cut tavas out of pink card stock in 1/2 is made it look like feathers!

7.) Finally glue those piece's on top of your nest create a completed design. 8.) The final step is to flip your project over and glue on a ribbon. Of the This is what you will use to hang the wreath. Allow the give to dry completely ? enjoy! Lovely Lula
