

# BIRDS NEST WREATH

HOW TO:



1.) BUY OR HAVE CUT  
A THIN PIECE OF  
WOOD INTO A CIRCLE.  
SIZE TEMPLATE IS  
ATTACHED AT END.



2.) PAINT WOOD ©  
W/ BROWN PAINT  
USING A VERY  
BRUSH STROKE  
METHOD.



3.) USE YOUR ROTARY CUTTER TO  
CUT  $\frac{1}{2}$  in.  $\frac{3}{4}$  in. WIDE BY 8 in LONG  
BROWN PAPER (CARD STOCK IS BEST)

4.) cover your painted wood ©  
w/ MOD PODGE AND START  
TO RANDOMLY LAY DOWN  
THE BROWN PAPER STRIPS  
creating a scrappy nest.

5.) ONCE all the paper pieces  
are down "paint" more Mod  
Podge over the entire surface.

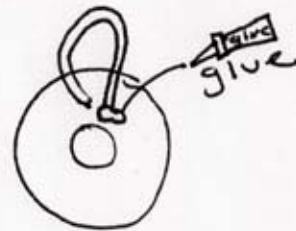
6.) Now is the time to bust  
out your cricut. choose  
a cartridge you like that  
has a bird on it. I used  
the Heritage cartridge to cut  
3 Birds out of blue card  
stock (80lb)

Then I used the Tie the Knot  
Cartridge to cut tiaras out of  
pink card stock. Note: I cut 1 tiara  
in 1/2 & made it look  
like feathers!

7.) Finally glue those piece's on top of your nest to create a completed design.

8.) The final step is to flip your project over and glue on a ribbon.

This is what you will use to hang the wreath. Allow the glue to dry completely  $\ni$  enjoy!

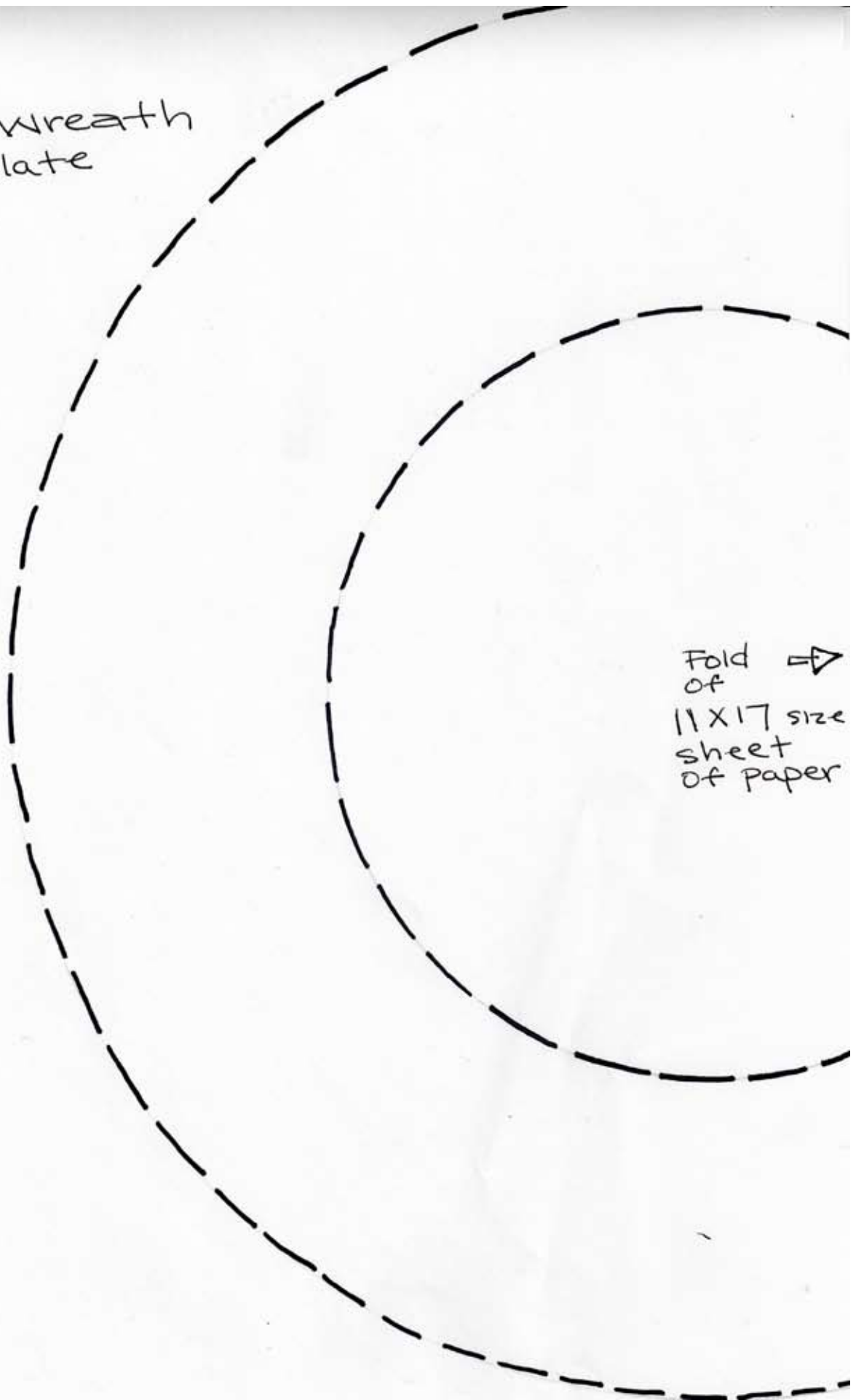


Notes: I cut one of the tie
