



Flower Hair Clip/pin

- 1.) BUY a vintage pillow case or piece of fabric from a thrift store. 
- 2.) Cut flower or other shape out of the fabric. Scale to your own use / desire. Mine is about 4 inches.
- 3.) Lay down on top of a piece of felt and glue w/ tacky glue. Allow to dry.

4.) Once the glue is dry - trim around flower, leaving a felt boarder.

5.) Next ready a piece of Sculpey by kneading it in your hands & rolling thin w/ a rolling pin.

6.) Press Sculpey into a Cuttlebug embossing folder. I used the Halloween Skull. Bake Sculpey according to package instructions
note: punch any ^{baking} holes you may want before

7.) Once cool - use a sharpie to outline details.



8.) Bling out the piece using the imaginisce irock. I used black & pink hot rocks.

9.) Flip over & glue on both a hair barrette and an alligator clip so it can also be used as a pin. Glue using



E-6000. All to dry completely.

You're done - now wear out and about showing off your fashionable self!
